- Safety is a top priority in any club especially a paddle sports club. Members must be aware of safety rules and take personal responsibility for their safety and the safety of others. This includes respecting instructions from instructors or Team Leaders while on the river.
- Members must also take care of property belonging to the club or any club members, including their own equipment and clothing. They must avoid any behaviour that may inconvenience or upset others as far as is reasonably practicable.

- When traveling to away events, members must represent the club with dignity. Your actions and behaviour represent the club, and it is essential to maintain a positive image.

- All communication between club members should be conducted in a courteous and respectful manner at all times. This includes all communications via the BPSC online communication forums or channels e.g BPSC Facebook page, WhatsApp group, Instagram, and the club email. Any member who fails to adhere to respectful and courteous communications when using club communication forums or channels, will have their access to BPSC online forums and communication channels terminated
- Finally, all medical conditions must be disclosed to ensure the safety of all members on the river. It is not just your life but those of others that may be at risk.
